Degrees Granted Report – Degrees Earned 2008-09

The Minnesota Private College Research Foundation annually reports degrees earned by students attending a Minnesota college or university. This report focuses on total bachelor's and master's degrees earned by sector and institution disaggregated by race/ethnicity. Also, as science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) are key disciplines for the future growth of Minnesota's economy, a separate section is dedicated to degrees earned in STEM areas.

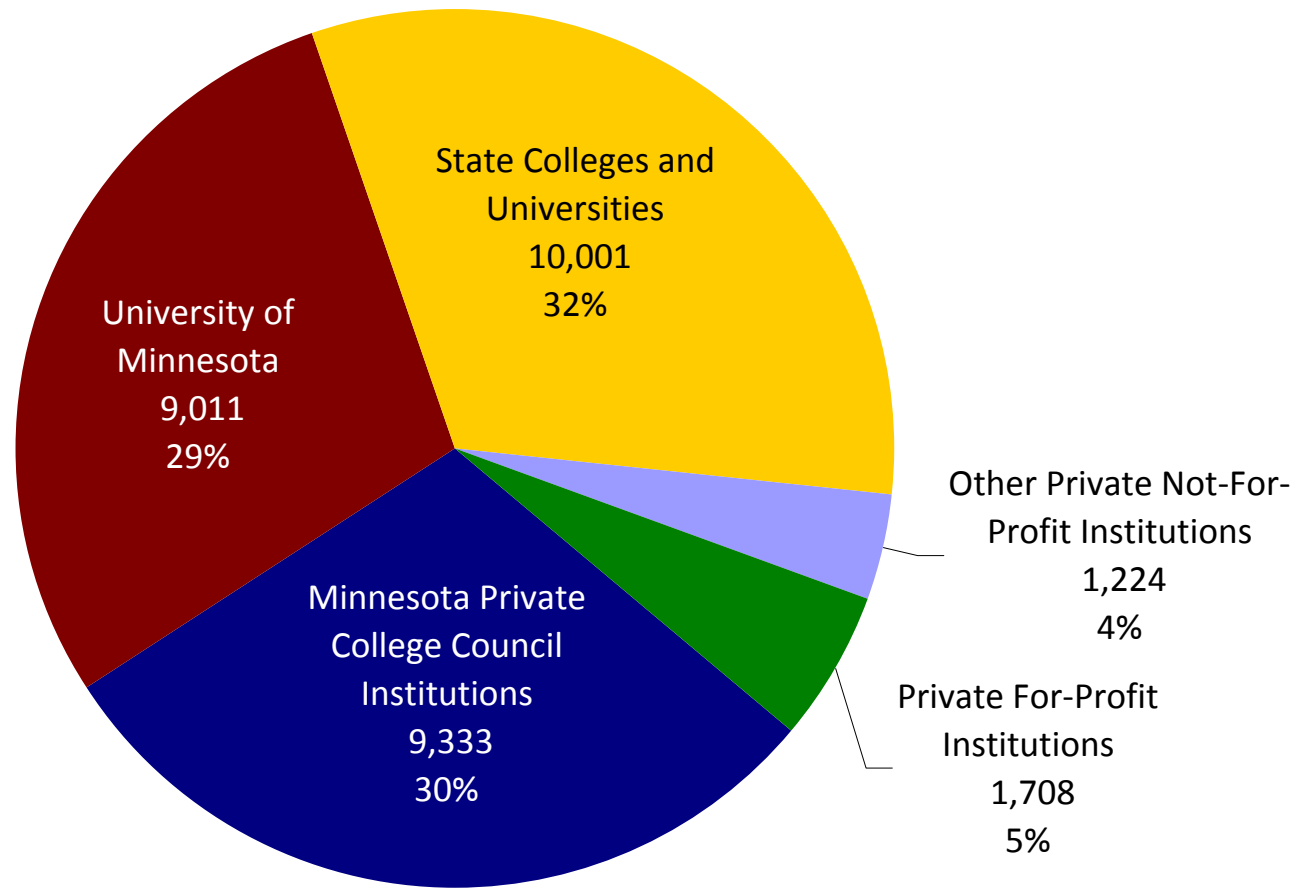
Members of the Minnesota Private College Council (MPCC) are strong contributors toward the education and labor force preparation of Minnesota's population. As shown, the 17 members provide nearly a third of all baccalaureate degrees produced and over a fifth of master's degrees. Member institutions also award nearly 30% of all bachelor degrees earned by students of color. Of degrees awarded in STEM disciplines, 28% are earned by MPCC students and 23% of students of color earning a STEM related degree are from an MPCC institution.

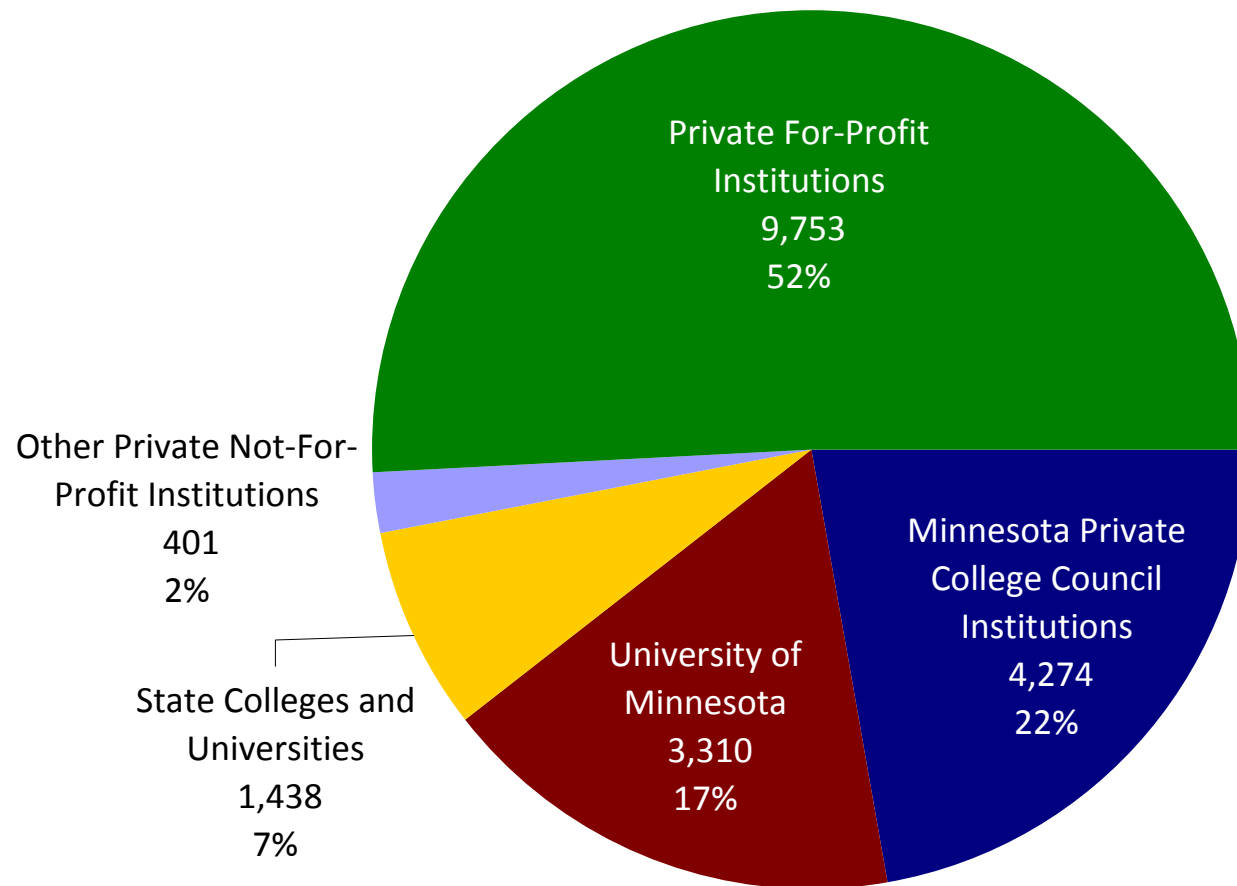

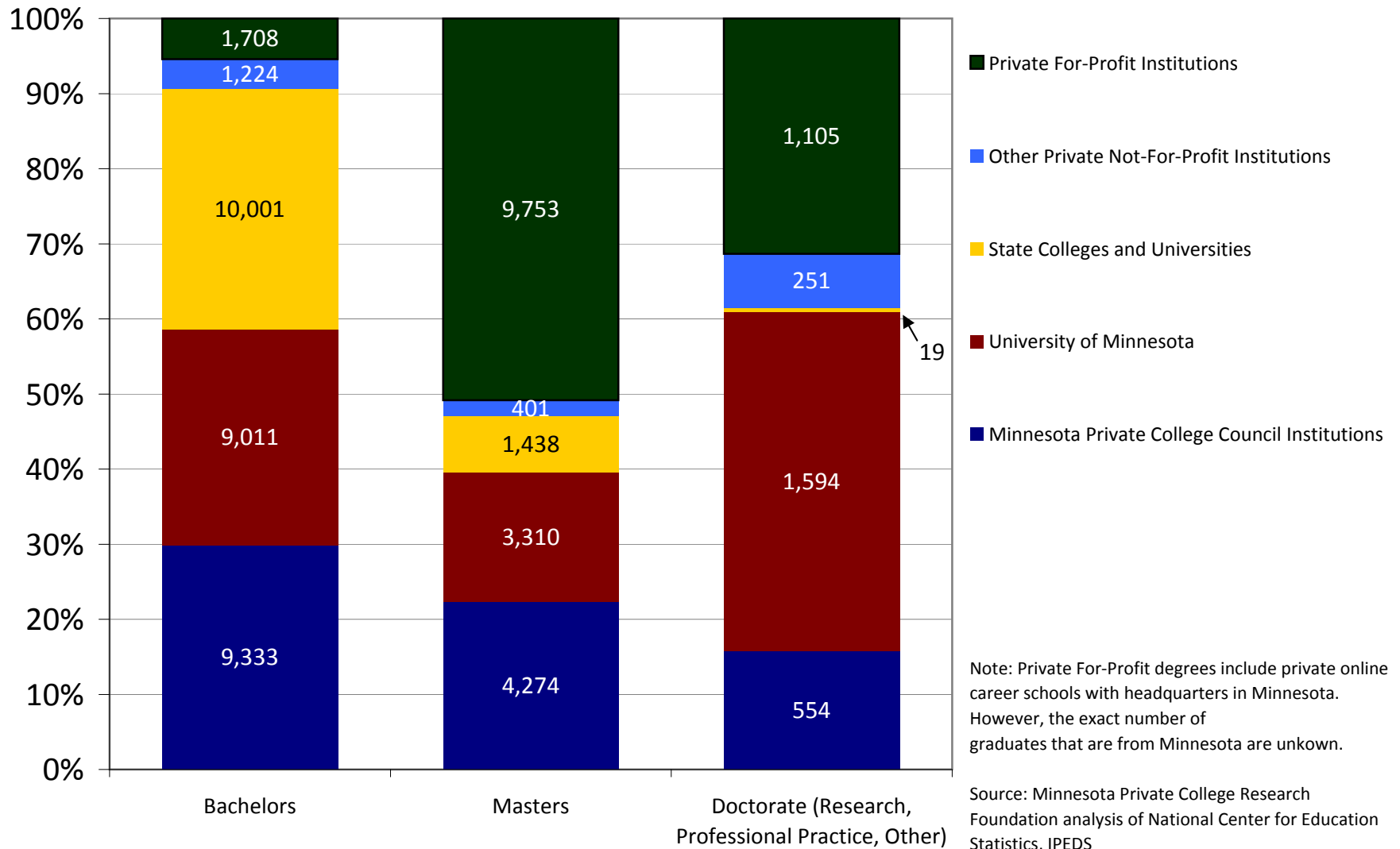
Master's Degrees Earned in Minnesota by Sector, 2008-09

Percent of Degrees Earned by Sector by Level, 2008-09



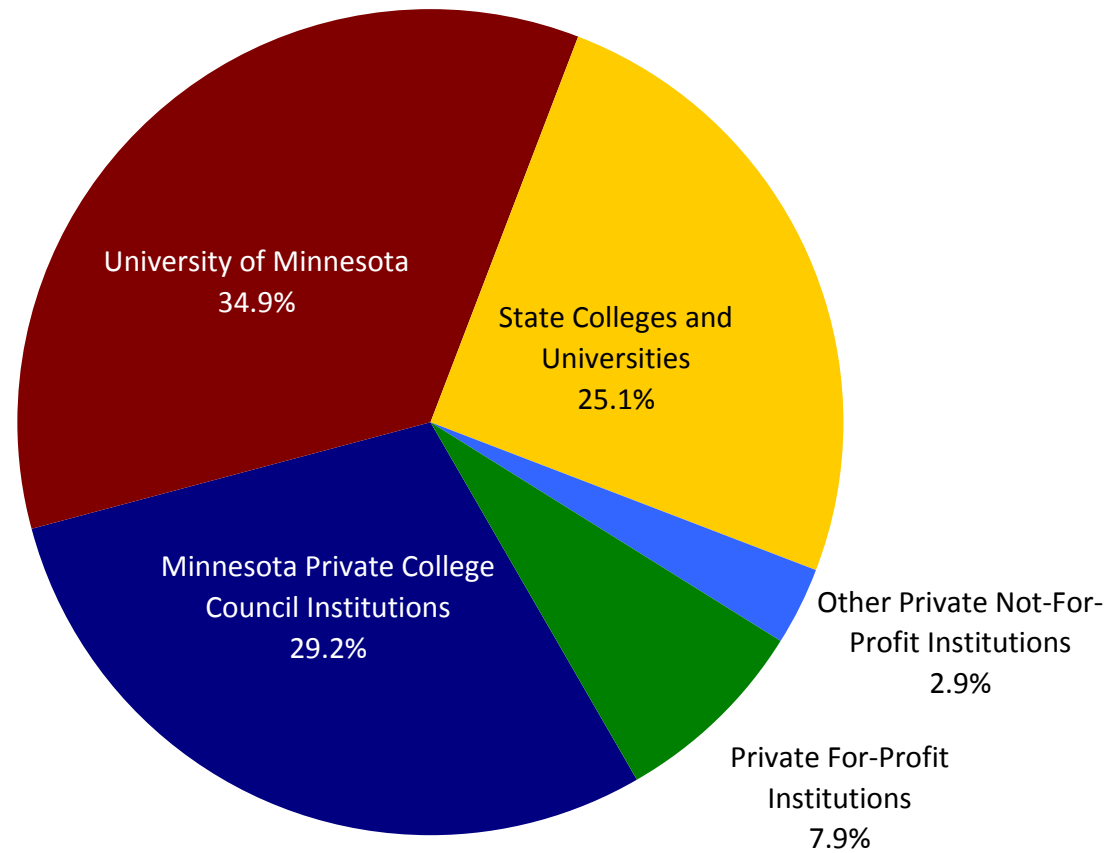

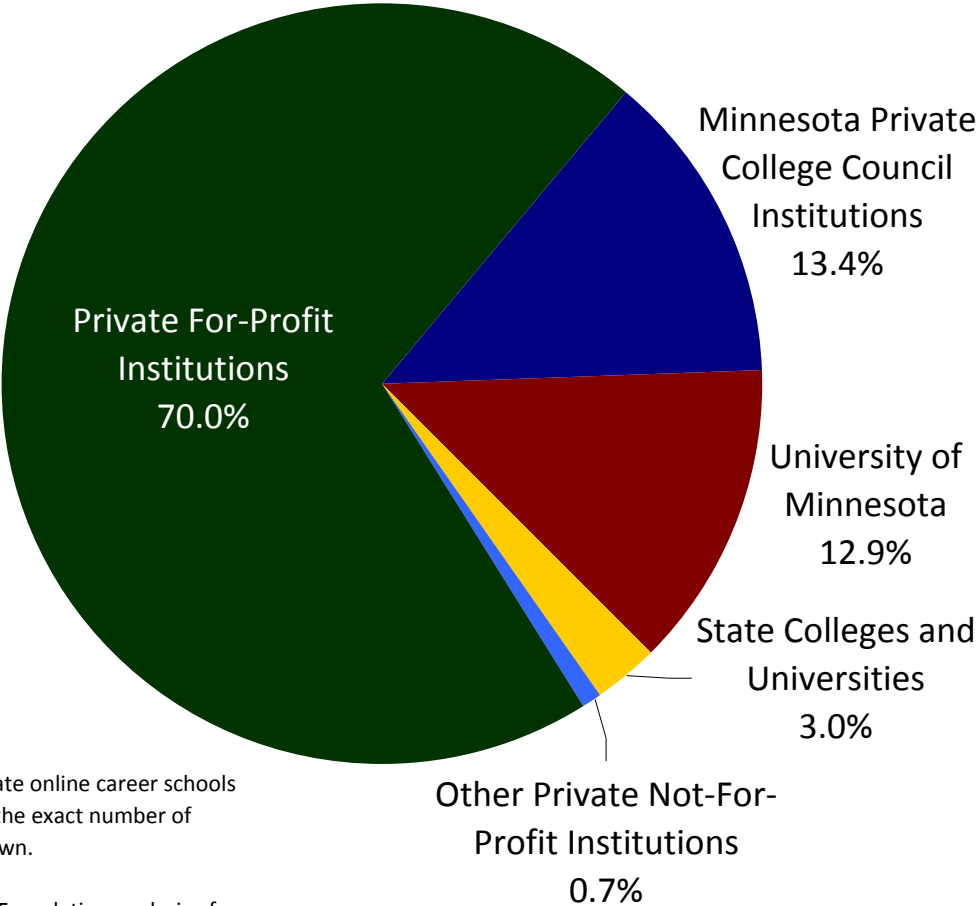

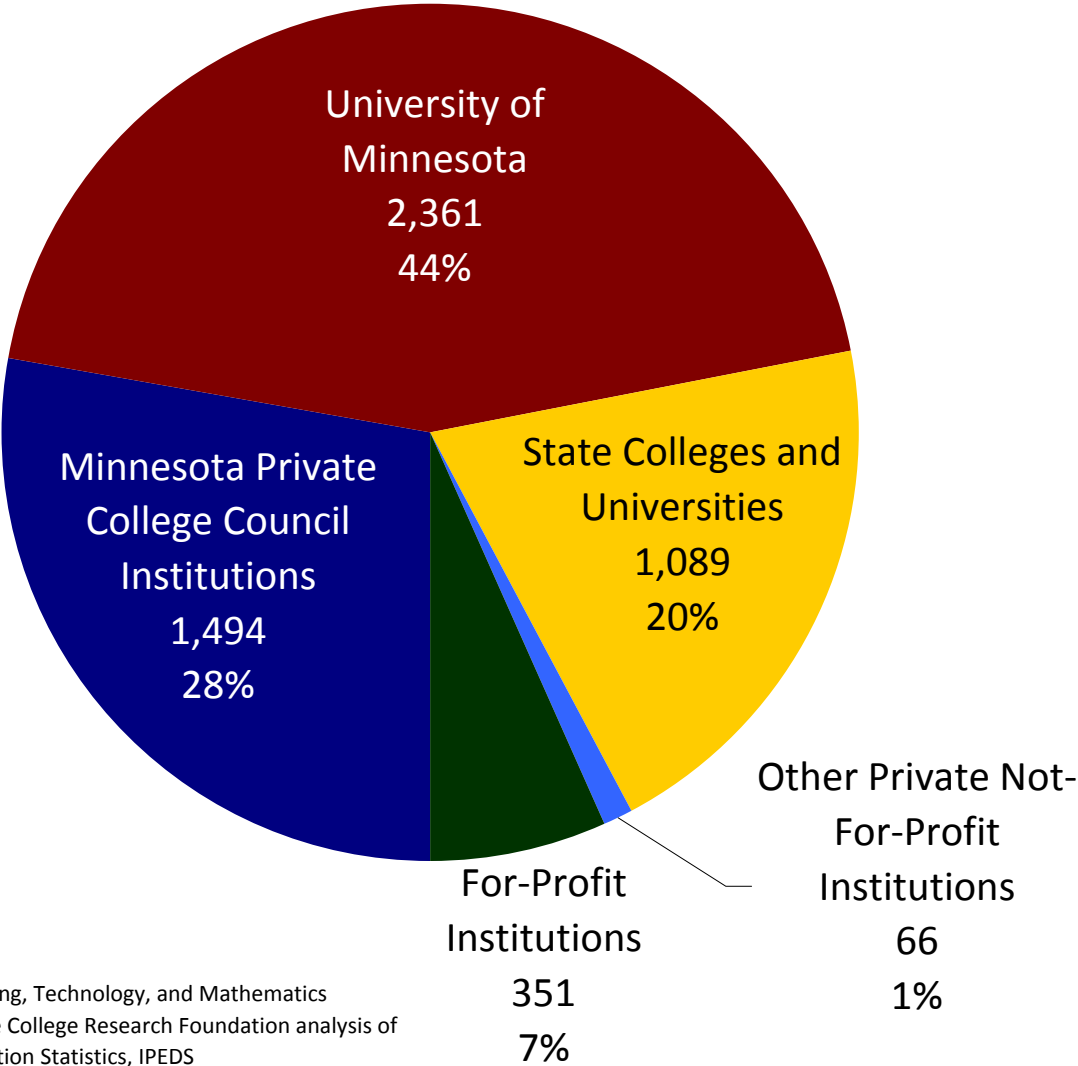

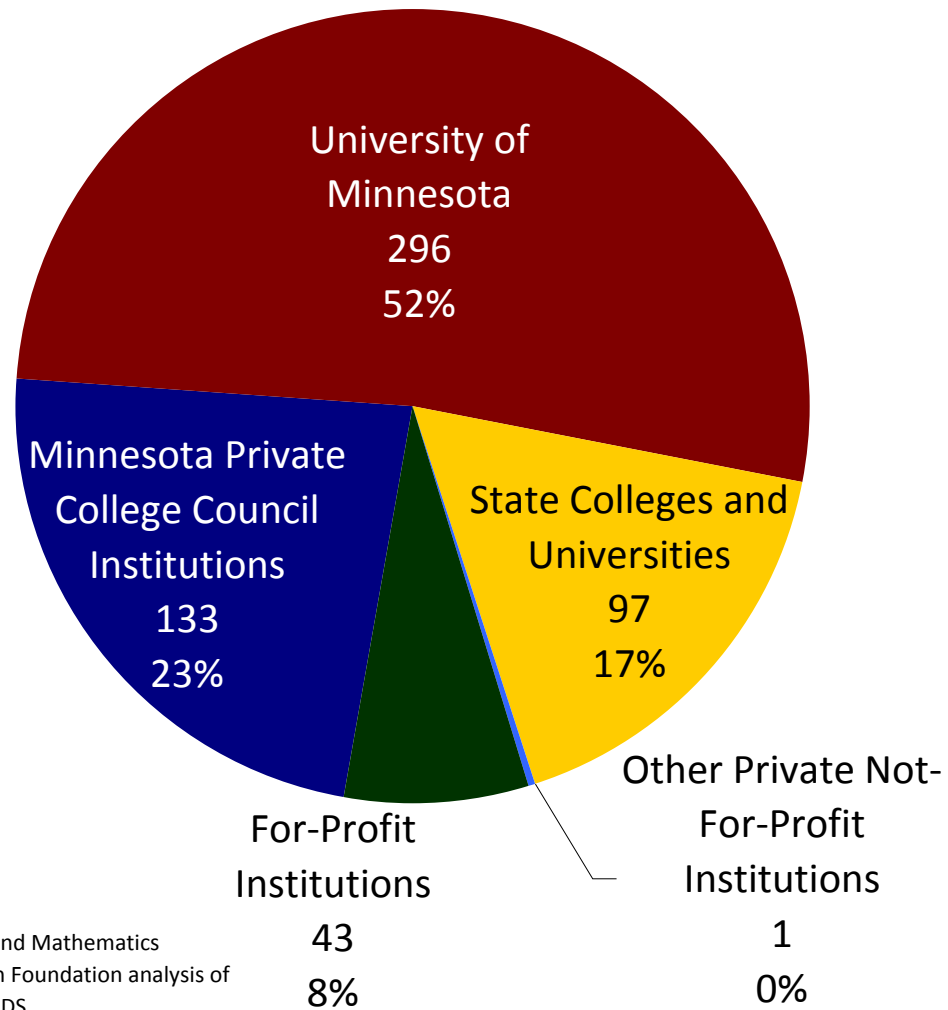
